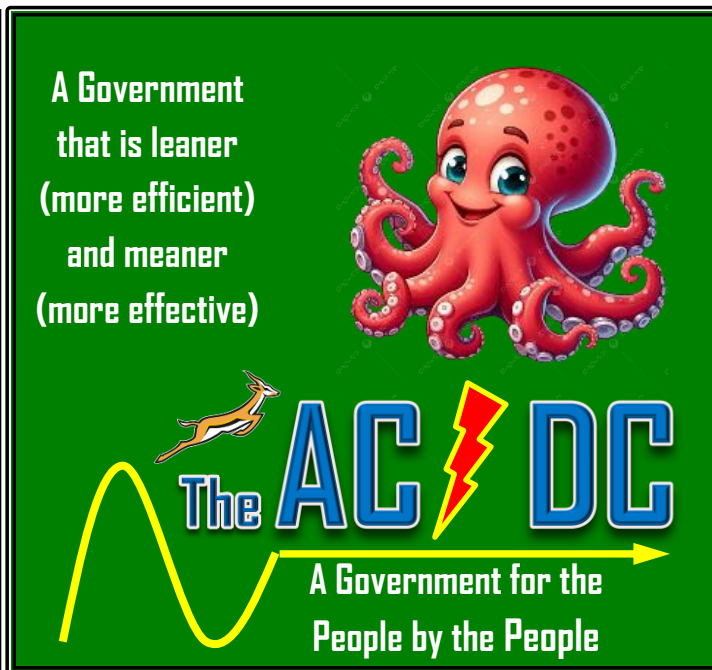

2. Politicians and People needed to solve the problems of South Africa:

P – Productive / Performance: A Pig can produce 25 piglets per year. Other milk producing farm animals will only give you one or two offspring per year. A piglet grows from 1.2kg birth weight to 80kg slaughter weight in just 120 days. Cattle for instance grow from 35kg birth weight to 450kg slaughter weight in 360 days. The performance of a pig is therefore much better than that of cattle. It increases its weight by 66 times in a third of the time it takes cattle to increase their mass 12-fold. This is the type of scenario that we must employ in the working environment of our leaders and the people of South Africa to pick up our Economic Growth rate so that we can create wealth and work for ALL the people of this country. Unless we do something about the work rate of politicians and other citizens we are doomed. If you evaluate and promote people on anything other than performance it is like playing rugby, soccer, cricket, netball or tennis with 2 balls. No one does that. It's irrational, illogical and counterproductive.

E – Efficient: Pigs convert their food to meat at a rate of 2.5kg eaten to 1kg growth. Cattle and sheep convert their food to meat at a rate of 6kg eaten to 1kg growth. The leaders and citizens of South Africa can be much more efficient in the way they utilize resources like tax money and other equipment like machinery, land etc. There is way too much wastage. This all boils down to integrity. Integrity is about your work ethic or attitude towards you job. Are you lazy or diligent? Are you Honest? Is your heart in your job?

A – Adaptable: A pig sow sustains herself with just 2.5kg of meal for the 3 months 3 weeks and 3 days or 114 days in total when she is dry. After her litter of 12 piglets is born the farmer increases her feed to 7.5kg in just seven days. She can therefore vary her feed intake drastically even by 3 times in order to take enough nutrients in to produce enough milk for her young. The politicians and people of South Africa need to more adaptable to the environment of our day. We need to be more pragmatic and put the past behind us. We need to bury the past or the past will bury us. We should be willing to think and act outside of the box and not follow the same bad ways and laws of other countries and peoples of the world.

C – Clever: A pig's water is not provided in the form of standing water in a water trough. Pig farmers put metal drinking water nipples in the pig pens because pigs are clever enough to use them and because it is a much cleaner and safer system. Pigs will always urinate and dirty where it is wet and dark. If you provide the young pigs with a heat light and a water drinking nipple, they will keep their sleeping area clean and dry by not messing there. No other farming animal will do this. Politicians and leaders of organizations needs to be clever, smart, talented, well trained and have sufficient experience in order to perform. Our leaders must be competent. It should be one of two selection criteria people are employed upon. The other being integrity. Your performance is determined by your competency and integrity. Competency is about your head and body and integrity is about your heart. People must be evaluated and selected based on their performance because this is what will drive our economy forward and enable us to create work by growing companies. Current state policy creates a loophole for corruption and bad work performance.

E – End: A pigs life cycle is quite short because of the above factors. We have 3 simple logical plans that will quickly end South Africa's problems like: Unemployment & Bad Economy, Crime and Bad Government.

The Ace of Spades (Spades is about Work related subjects)

The Octopus or Pyramid style of the Ancient Egyptian and Israel Governments is the way any **government, state, company or group** where people work together must be set up. Pyramids are built from the bottom upwards to the top after each stone has been dressed perfectly to fit its place. Its workforce should enter from below by competing equally according to the factors that will determine the **outcome** of their work namely **A) their integrity or work ethic or attitude towards work**, which involves hard work, enthusiasm, energy and honesty as well as **B) their skill level** which involves talent, training and experience. The Egyptian government was set up like a pyramid. You read that in Exodus 18:21 in the Bible where Moses's Arabian father-in-law advises him on how to set up a government for Israel based on the experience of Moses as he grew up as the adopted son of the daughter of the faro. You also see principles the Egyptians used to choose the building blocks of their governmental pyramids namely its workers in the interaction between Joseph and Faro in Genesis 41:33-34. The pyramids they build as burial chambers for their heads of state, the faro, resembled how their governments worked. The capstone on top resembled the faro. You see this capstone in the all-seeing eye on the American one Dollar note. Both the Egyptian pyramids and the Israeli government that dates back from 3500 years ago are still standing today as monuments to the legacy of the success of this very simple governmental idea discovered by the ancient Egyptians. Do not reinvent the wheel. When the state or any organisation is set up like a pyramid the top structure of the organization can **monitor** and **control** what is happening on ground level. The South African State is not set up like a pyramid. You can see evidence for this in the fact that the state resurfaced minor relative quiet streets in Jeffreys Bay that were in a relatively good condition and not the main and busy street that is in bad condition. A 30 km generally **good quiet** gravel road between Jansenville and Kliplaat in the **Eastern Cape** province was tarred while a 30km **busy generally bad** gravel road between Humansdorp and Oyster Bay, also in the **Eastern Cape** was not tarred during the same time.

Formula for testing which road needs priority to be tarred if it has a gravel surface - Six of Spades
 $1(\text{General quality of road over time}) \times 2 + 2(\text{Quality of roadbuilding gravel}) + 3(\text{Amount of yearly rainfall}) + 4(\text{Does the road has many inclines}) + 5(\text{Does the road cross many streams}) + 6(\text{Is the surface of the road higher than the side and therefore well drained}) + 7(\text{How much light traffic does the road carry}) \times 2 + 8(\text{How much heavy traffic does the road carry}) \times 2 = \text{Total Score}$

Give the severity of these 8 different factors numbers and then add up the scores to get a **Total score**. If you **compare** the **Total scores** of the different South African gravel roads, you can rank them in order of priority to be tarred. **First** tar the one with the highest Total score.

Formula for testing which road needs priority to be resurfaced if it has a tar surface.

$1(\text{General road surface quality of the road}) + 2(\text{How much traffic does the road carry including heavy traffic}) + 3(\text{Speed of traffic on the road}) = \text{Total Score}$

Points to be allocated as follows:

Quality of 1Road, 2Gravel, 6Drainage **Good=1; Average=2; Bad=3; Very Bad=4**

Amount of 3Yearly Rainfall **0 to 300 =1; 300 to 600 =2; 600 to 750 =3; 750mm and more = 4**

Density of 4Inclines, 5Streams **One every 0 to 4km = 4; every 4 to 8km = 3; every 8 to 12km =2**

Density of 7Light Traffic **1 to 2 /hour = 1; 3 to 4 /hour = 2; 5 to 8 /hour = 3; 9 to 12 hour = 4**

Density of 8Heavy Traffic **1 per day = 1; 2 per day =2; 3 per day = 3; 4 or more per day = 4**

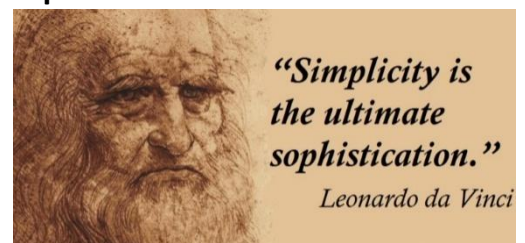
Max road speed: 60kmpH = 1; 80kmpH =2; 100kmpH = 3; 120kmpH = 4

Kliplaat Jansenville Rd = $1 \times 2 + 1 + 1 + 1 + 1 + 1 + 1 \times 2 + 1 \times 2 = 11$ points

H'dorp Oysterbay Rd = $4 \times 2 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 \times 2 + 4 \times 2 = 44$ points

It was **4** times more important to tar the road surface area of the Humansdorp/Oysterbay Rd, yet it was **NOT** done.

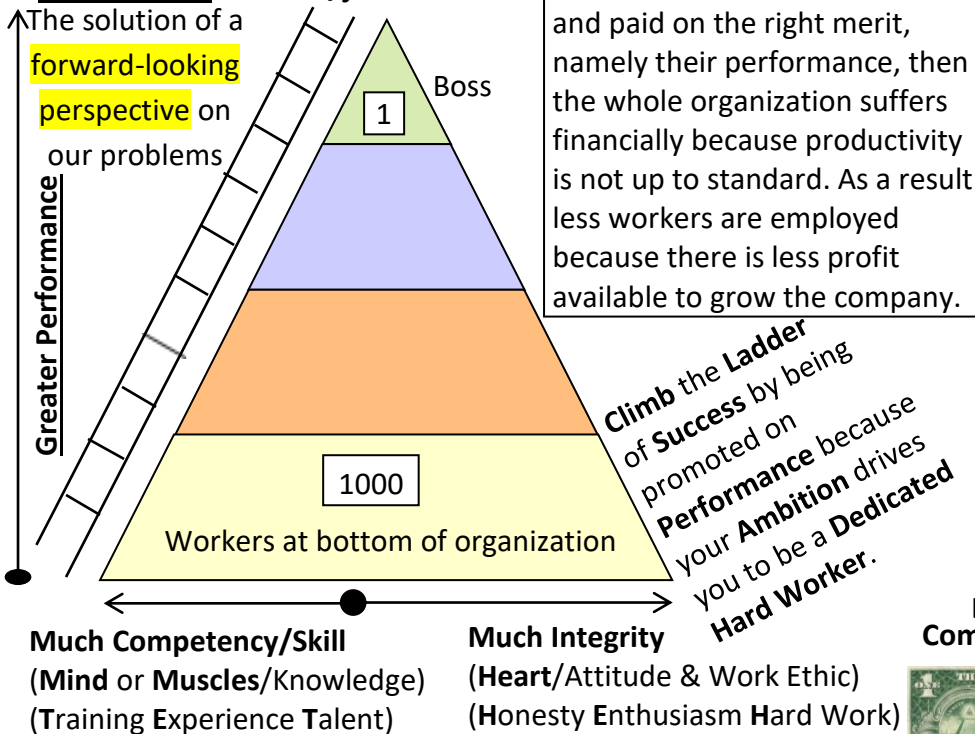


1. Policy of the Pyramid: Improving performance in **all organisations** and companies.

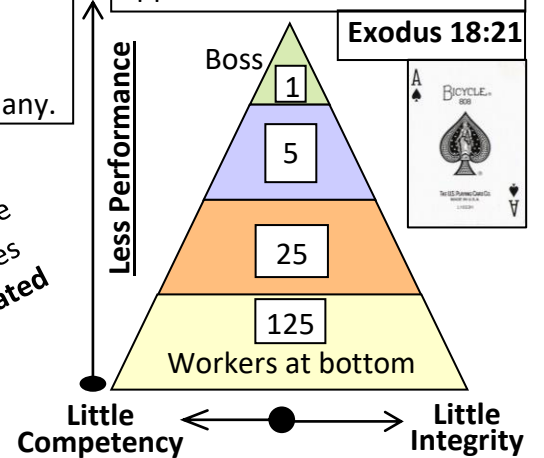

The current South African government seems to think they can reinvent the wheel to monetary success. If we apply this principle, it will create productive, competent, and efficient organizations that will create more wealth, jobs, financial success and eliminate corruption and poverty. Entrepreneurs only invest in businesses if they perform financially. If we want entrepreneurs to investment in our economy, we need to apply this tried and tested method and reject everything that is counterproductive. The same apply for the state.

1.Appointment, promotion & pay rise based on justice & fairness by evaluating performance:

Big pyramid: wealth/job creator



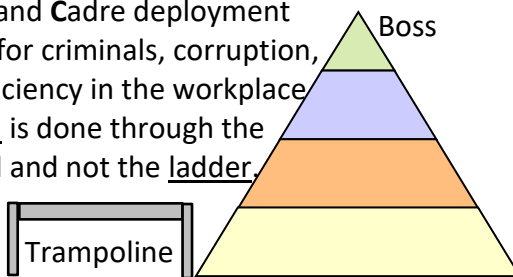
The higher the top of the pyramid the bigger its volume and the larger its base. The better employees of an organization the more job opportunities are created.

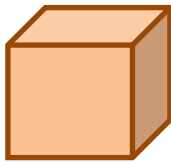
Poor Blacks don't have access to the trampoline.



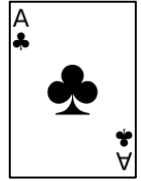
A **backwards looking perspective** on the solution to South Africa's problems creates a backwards solution. This is being cent wise & Rand foolish. You make small gains but lose all the big battles. The economy suffers because of bad performance due to lack of integrity and competency in **crucial** work positions. The **poor** suffers mostly as little employment is created.

You cannot fix the injustices of the past with injustice. People must be promoted and given opportunities based on their performance. That is just and fair. God will never bless a government or country with unjust policies. The man at the top of any organization should be the most competent person who has proven over many years that he has integrity. All employees or sportsmen should be appointed based only on factors that will determine their performance, like Skill & Integrity. Skin colour or pigmentation does not determine skill and as a result performance. If you use factors that plays no role in how well someone will perform in their appointment like skin colour, hair colour or gender then their performance is not important to you or to them. You cannot play rugby with **two balls**, soccer with **two balls** or tennis with **two balls**. You cannot use **two criteria** (of which one is **irrelevant** to the **outcome** of the job) when you appoint or promote somebody and expect to build a successful economy and society. Just one bad apple can make the whole box rot. We should strive only for excellence, and the injustices of the past will be sorted out naturally. This is the main reason why the R.S.A. has the highest unemployment rate worldwide. ***We must bury the past or the past will bury us! Keep the past in the past! The Pyramid Plan is the Black Ace of Spades. The spade is a tool of labour. It symbolises honest hard work & work skill as the way to success and prosperity for all.***

2. Policy of the Block: Solving the crime problem quickly & cheaply with **single cell prisons**.



Proverbs 20²⁶ A wise king winnows the wicked and drives the wheel over them.



The conveyor belt rehabilitation system of catch and release through fast and intensive rehabilitation.

Catch a Criminal and release a Christian! Christians do not Steal, Murder, Rape or exploit children.

The four categories of Criminals:

1. Lawless Criminal: (Drunken driving and other very serious traffic violations, public insubordination)
2. Petty Criminal: (Intimidation of colleagues, Destruction of public property, Public violence and looting)
3. Normal Criminal: (Murder, Robbing and stealing, Rape, Corruption, Child abuse and Abalone poachers)
4. **Hard Criminal:** (Organised criminals like armed robbers, violent drug criminal gangs, Rhino poachers)

Nine of clubs – A simple plan for the **Minister of Police** to give a monetary reward to citizens who report criminals that are eventually found guilty in court to help the police make more arrests. At the heart of this plan is changes to the unnecessary procedures that make it too difficult for police to arrest criminals.

This will speed up arrests and prevent **hard criminals** from getting off the hook because of all the red tape involved in detective work and filing that must reach the court. It will save much time and money and because the prison sentence will be so short. Currently some people are sitting in jail for years before they are being sentenced, without getting bail. This will therefore also prevent innocent people from spending lengthy periods in prison before they are prosecuted. Because so much money and time can be saved through this strategy the Police can afford to pay the citizens that report these criminals a set amount per criminal. They will be like our own bounty hunters, except the Police will go do the arrest immediately. Additionally, the Police and detectives will also still be involved in investigations like before.

Seven of clubs – A perfect plan for the **Minister of Justice** to process criminals through the judicial system very quickly without any wrong judgements. At the heart of this plan is the use of a third umpire like in cricket. The minimum prison time or fine per Criminal category will be something in the order of:

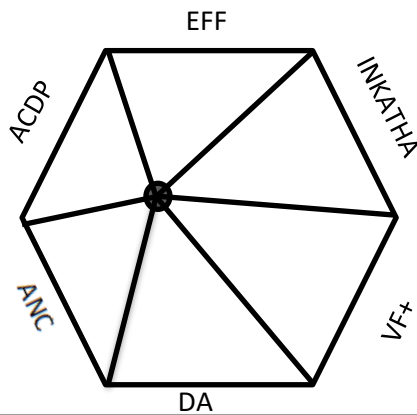
1. Lawless Criminal: Judge decides
2. Petty Criminal: Judge decides
3. Normal Criminal: 160 days min.
4. Hard Criminal: 160 days min.

Jailed criminals will only be released once they are rehabilitated. The rehabilitation course will take a minimum of 160 days if they give their cooperation. Their progress will be monitored daily by reports they write on Bible chapters, gospel related questions etc. Matthew 18: 23-35

Ace of Clubs: We shall involve the army to build temporary individual prison cells for prisoners on excess public or current prison sport fields. The prison cells will be a wooden box consisting of 8 shutter boards, 4 x 3m poles, 2" X 2" beams for connecting the corners and giving it structural integrity and a corrugated iron roof across. Prisoners will sleep on a mattress and have a twenty-litre paint bucket with lid as chair. They will use a tray to write on and answer questions on the Gospel Flag and the Bible. The Gospel message is behind the flag of our military wing. There is plenty of evidence that any criminal can be rehabilitated by Jesus in a solitary and quiet environment in a short time. Their nails will be cut short, and no metal utensils will be allowed inside these wooden boxes. Nobody can claw through a shutter board with his bare hands. We will change the atmosphere in South Africa from where the community is afraid of criminals, to one where the criminals are afraid of the community and the state for a change. Criminals will come and hand themselves over at the Police Station to get imprisoned out of fear for the consequences if they don't. Current prisons hold up to 60 prisoners per cell! Not good for rehabilitation. Once the current prisoners are transferred from existing prisons to new wooden single cells there will be more space to house new prisoners in the emptied cells. They will not get exposed and corrupted by the old prison value system and culture of gangs, violence etc. and might be rehabilitated there to save time and money.

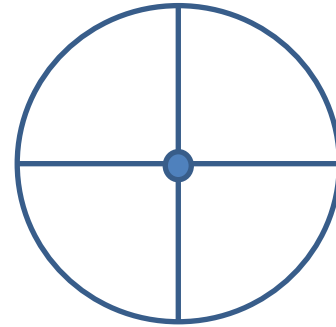
The Prison Plan is based on quick rehabilitation of criminals. Clubs have three branches namely the Police, Courts and Correctional Service. A Club represents the aggressive way this plan will tackle crime.

South African Multiparty Democracy vs. the original Greek democracy in Athens.



A multi sided wheel with an off-centre axis

Multiple parties make up the democracy (multi sided wheel) but are not all represented in the cabinet (off-centre axis) Voters are incapable of voting in the best politicians, because they do not know them all and the individual politicians also hide behind their party. The whole system is so big and clumsy that the voters are incapable of making a well-informed decisions based on the merit of the candidates. Voters do not vote for individual candidates like it was in the original Greek democratic system but rather for parties who obscure the identity of their candidates. There are infighting in these different parties and also between the parties because of the powerplay between them. This is represented by the bumpy ride caused by a multi sided wheel of different political parties. Multi-party governments just do not function like a pyramid and can therefore not compete with the private sector when it comes to efficiency. If you put a wheel like this in your car and it is going to get very bouncy inside. Nobody would even contemplate doing this, namely, to redesign the wheel; yet modern countries all over the world have done this with democracy.



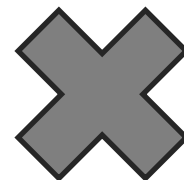
A round wheel with a central axis

Democracy was first practised in Athens Greece 2600 ago. Fifty politicians were voted to rule at a time. Because it was a city where the people knew each other each individual were voted in on his own merit by all the voters. There were no political parties, just individuals known by everyone. It was like voting for the student council at a school by the students. It resembles the wheel therefore. The problem of how to best adopt that original Greek model on a large population of a country to pick the best candidates and retain the democratic process has never been solved until the AC/DC came along. **Democracy means many capable voters that are a representative group of the whole population votes on a single clearly defined issue.** Because the parties obscure their individual candidates SA do not have a democracy but rather a perversion of a true democracy. China has a one-party autocratic government but look how well they are able to govern 1.3 billion people with discipline and authority and with very good economic growth as proof. 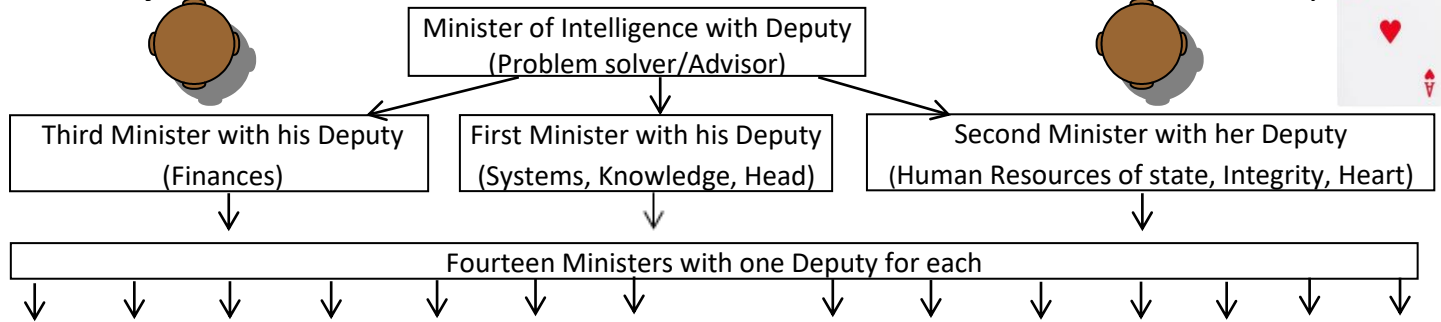

The major problem is unemployment. It will be our goal to solve the mass unemployment South Africa has. To help with this we will also address crime and corruption whose participants are like parasites who suck money out of the economy without making any contribution and out of the pockets of hardworking South Africans.

3. Policy of the circle: Create an efficient **Government** and save time, effort & money.



Each Minister has a Provincial Administrator and a Reserve Administrator in each province to help him manage his State Department in that province. The Administrators of the Minister of State-Owned Enterprises is not divided by province, but rather one administrator per State-Owned Enterprise. The Minister of Urban Employment will have one Administrator per million people of the population. His administrators will be shop-stewards in the workplace.

We can simplify the whole government by ruling it with a **cabinet of ministers** and their deputies from the Union Building in Pretoria our administrative capital. The ministers will have oversight over their respective **national departments** through a **provincial administrator** who will be working from the capital city of their respective province. There will be two rings of power. The 35-member **cabinet ministerial** ring at the top and the less than 200 member **Parliamentarian** ring at the bottom consisting of the **Provincial Administrator**s who will vote on the ideas of the top. When the Provincial Parliamentarians are in their respective provinces they will do administrative work, but when the Parliament convenes to decide on new laws or big ideas that affect the whole country they will do the voting in parliament on the decisions taken by the cabinet. If a law passes both these rings of power by a majority, the decision stands. The process starts by the Voted President picking every person in the top ring, namely the 3 Top Ministers and their Deputy's as well as the 14 ministers below them and their Deputy's by using the best candidates in all the political parties. Each Minister of a department then picks his own Administrators, one for each province to serve under them to help them manage their respective departments in the respective provinces. **Vacant Provincial Administrator positions** will be filled through job applications of capable and qualified citizens in the general public for the different departments in the different provinces that will be received, sorted and judged to a manageable number (20) by the Human Resources Department and then passed on to the respective minister of each department. A minister will then choose whom he wants to conduct job interviews with from these applications. The top 5 candidates he selects after having job interviews must come and present himself/herself in front of all the Parliamentarians or Provincial Administrators in Parliament so that they can establish through a majority vote who will fill the vacant position. If a minister resigns or loses his position his/her deputy below him/her takes his/her position. If there is a new minister, he picks his new deputy from one of the politicians under him. This will create more continuity in government. Companies appoint new employees through job applications and interviews.

The meaning of the Flag's colours
