## **The one word that sums up all of South Africa's problems and the reasons why our problems are not solved.**

All the problems of South Africa can be summed up in one word. It starts with the letter M. It is not a person. It is **MONEY**. South Africa has a money problem, and it runs like a rotten thread through all our problems. It should therefore also run like a golden thread through the solutions for all the diverse problems of South Africa. Money is also the only subject that unites everyone in South Africa. Everyone can do with more money. Nobody has a bank account that is full. The unifying value of the people of South Africa has always been the desire to make a good living in peace. Peace and prosperity in other words. Peace and prosperity needs political unity and the right government plans and policies to create the platform for ordinary citizens to capitalise on the opportunities in the South African economy or the company called the South African business landscape which is wherever the Rand is being used as a currency of exchange. The people of South must produce products that can be exchange for money to create wealth for themselves and their fellow citizens. 2. Because of all this unemployment and lack of economic growth there is much poverty in South Africa, as can be the best seen in the living conditions of so many South Africans in the townships. **Poverty** is a MONEY problem.
3. Because some people earn no money, because of unemployment and others earn money in the shape of varying size salaries, there is consequently much inequality in South Africa. **Inequality** is a MONEY problem.
4. South Africa has a serious problem with crime, to the extent that the police, judiciary system and prisons are overwhelmed. There are about 1 million arrests made by the police annually but only 30 thousand criminals or 3 percent are being convicted and locked up by the state. There are 167 thousand prisoners in jails in South Africa while the prisons are designed to house only 100 thousand prisoners. This means there is severe overcrowding in some prisons. Prisoners are also not being rehabilitated. These very lawless and in many cases violent men are locked up together in too great numbers and they therefore violently and immorally target one another resulting in a very dangerous and lawless environment. Most crime, even violent crime, in South Africa is driven by **smuggling illegal substance, theft or corruption** in the **private sector** or the **state**. These are all MONEY motivated actions.
5. There is a lot of infrastructure related problems in local municipalities that do not supply basic services up to the right standard, due to people that get good salaries but are then guilty of mismanagement of funds, laziness, corruption and lack of skills. **Poor Local government service delivery** therefore also revolves around MONEY.

The only reason why these problems are not being resolved, but rather worsen, is because the parties in charge of the government are not doing their work, which is to address all these issues. They have one third of all the money in circulation thanks to taxes. They make all the laws and can enforce them with the police. Their position gives them all influence. They have been in power for more than 30 years and still too many South Africans suffer because there is not enough money to live on. **Why are these parties still ruling South Africa?** Ask the **VOTERS** of South Africa.

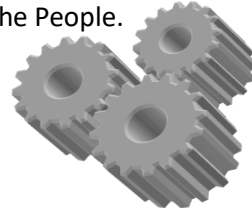

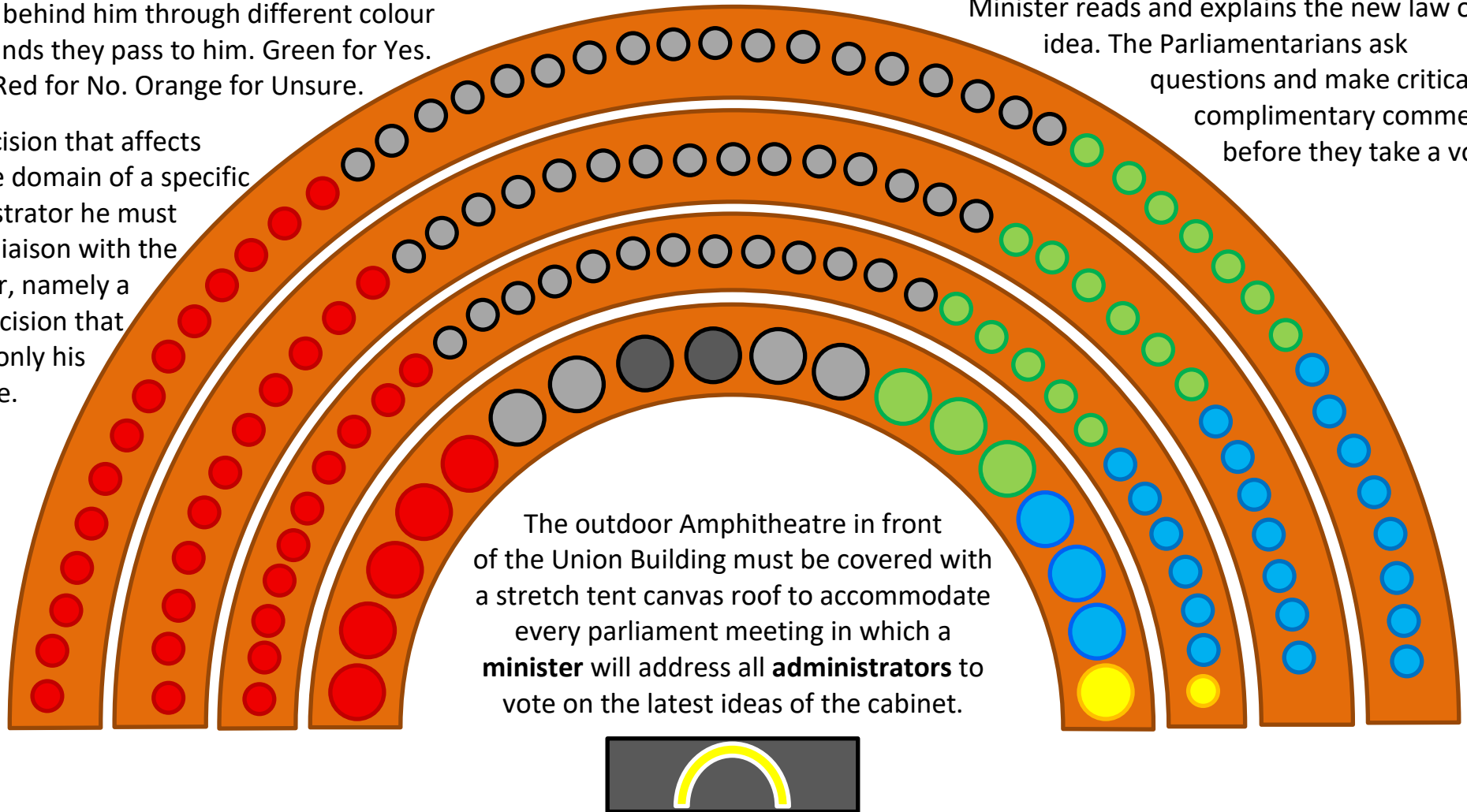
## Ace of Hearts: Basic Layout of Parliament and its rules

The Ministers of the different departments sit in the front row, and their Administrators or Parliamentarian Voters sit behind them. Each minister counts the votes casted by his voters behind him through different colour armbands they pass to him. Green for Yes. Red for No. Orange for Unsure.

Any decision that affects how a whole department is being run must be taken through a cabinet vote that follows the same pattern as parliament.

Any decision the cabinet have taken that will affect all citizens of South Africa have to be vetoed by the Parliamentarians or Administrators. The relevant Departmental Minister reads and explains the new law or idea. The Parliamentarians ask questions and make critical or complimentary comments before they take a vote.

Any decision that affects only the domain of a specific Administrator he must take in liaison with the Minister, namely a local decision that affects only his province.



New Administrators are voted in by the Administrators after the relative Departmental Minister in which the new opening is has interviewed candidates and chosen 5. The Candidates apply by sending in their C.V. to the Prime Minister's Secret Service.

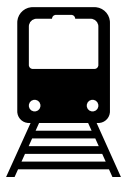


**Nine of Diamonds:** A plan for the **Minister of State-owned Enterprises** to solve the problems at **SA Railways**.

The demise of South African Railways started after the government started to change a winning recipe. The old steam trains were built and repaired in South Africa and ran on South African fuel, coal. The coal was put on a railcar behind the steam train. The running cost of coal generated energy is much less than the diesel generated energy that was used by the railway engines that replaced the sexy and beautiful old steam engines. This is evident by the fact that Eskom generates electricity by diesel for R6000 per MWh which is 10 to 12 times more than the coal fired power stations. Diesel locomotives were imported, cost more, broke more and had a shorter lifespan than Steam trains. The whole industrial revolution was driven by the success of the steam engine and countries like the USA developed greatly as a result. Why was steam trains not good enough anymore? Because they were old technology and that's the only reason. Who is the idiot that made this decision? Then they decided to replace the diesel locomotives again with electric trains that ran on electricity made at coal fired power stations because they can run on cheaper fuel. Why didn't they just go back to the steam train? The only problem is all this electricity had to be transported all over this vast railway network in cables that ran above the trains creating a second set of infrastructure above the train tracks that also needed maintenance. It is far easier to transport the coal along the railway line in a train that travels along it in any case, than to bring the electricity in from the power station. Then came loadshedding. There is way too much liberalism and way too few conservatism in the field of mechanical and electronic engineering. This is not the case in Civil engineering. If something is strong enough or good enough than its perfect. Anything more or less is an overdesign or an under design. A steam train is the perfect engine to pull a train in South Africa. Transnet can build them and they can run on raw South African fuel and fall in line with the **Ace of Diamonds** that will boost the South African Economy.

It's very important that heavy long haulage is done by rail to protect the road network. The problem with electric trains is they require infrastructure below the train (tracks) and above the train (electric cables) that both need maintenance. If diesel is a viable means of heavy load transportation on the road, then it should also be on the train track. SAR must get back on track!

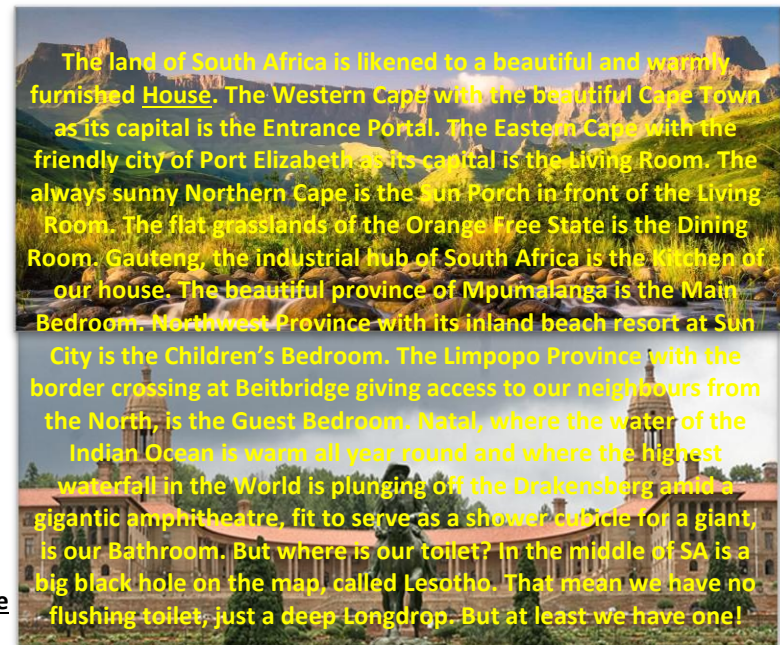
Today filling trains with water is much easier than in the old days, because there are water pumps today and the train does not have to park under an overhead water tower. The coal can also be loaded onto the JILL at the stations by means of a big, tracked loader from a heap that gets dumped there by a train that must travel past the station in any case. The train can generate its own electricity from the spinning axels and then power a conveyor belt at the bottom of the JILL to feed the burning chamber of coal in the locomotive. The coal can glide of a metal shoot into this chamber so that the train driver does not have to load the coal with a spade like in the old days. 1. **Green** fuel tank with Springbok emblem and name. **White** soft Seat. **Orange** metal frame and protecting bars. **Black** knobby tyres and rubber parts for tacks. This motorbike must be powered by a very efficient **redesigned 29 Kw internal combustion engine** that weighs about 12kg and that generates **electricity for two motors** mounted in

the centre of the back wheel. It will therefore have no chain or gearbox. There will be three models. A City and Town model that can be used for deliveries or travel to work or school called a **CT**. An All-terrain model for construction sites, farms and mines that will be called a **AT**. The only difference between these two motorbikes should be their Tyres. Both should have **Orange** crash bars to protect the body of the motorbike from damage, handlebar protectors to protect the two hand operated brakes for the two respective wheels with added **green** plastic covers on the outside to protect the drivers' hands from cold wind. There is no foot pedals on this motorbike, neither clutch nor back wheel foot brake. Just an accelerator and two hand operated brakes. Its front mud guard should also be **green**. The mechanical parts are **silver** but all the soft plastic like electric wire piping and handle grips of rubber should be **black**. The green tank is where the food of the Springbok is stored and the colours white, orange and black are for the colours of the springbok. This motorbike therefore uses the basic colours of our cabinet. Black and white and yellow for the ministries and green for the money in our care. Once these two motorbikes have been built and tested as prototypes Denel should also design an Adventure

motorbike that has two of this same 29Kw engines to give you a 58kw motorbike called an **AD** for long distance travel on and off road. This is also known as a Dual-Purpose motorbike, The motorbike should have some of the design features of the Bigboy 125 Legend and the build quality of the Yamaha TW200. The AD motorbike should have the same look as the CT and the AT smaller version motorbikes.



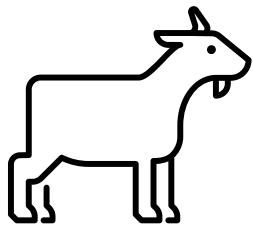
2.A **White** or **Golden** 0.5ton short wheelbase city bakkie with the side view of a **White** Bantam rooster on the **Black** grill as its emblem and the name **DENEL** in **Black** on its load body back flap. Behind of both doors against the body should be its model name **Bantam bakkie** written in large **Black**. There should be a black plastic strip inside the groove along the side of the golden model to protect the paint from parking lot accidents as well as for aesthetics. The white model should get a black fluid spat pattern behind the front wheel door. This bakkie should make use of this same redesigned engine but this time a large engine of 75 Kw that weighs about just 75kg. This is an entry level vehicle that should have hand winding windows, no remote-control locking system, a needle speedometer and mechanical odometer with as little as possible of the unnecessary and unpractical electronics you get in modern cars that make them expensive, unreliable and unnecessary complex. Once a prototype has been tested the load body of the bakkie should be turned into a backseat and boot to convert the bakkie into a budget small **two-door** hatchback car like VW City Golf called **BANTAM CT** (City Town)



If this bakkie is given a removable roof or sunroof it can be a beach buggy or cabriolet type of vehicle.



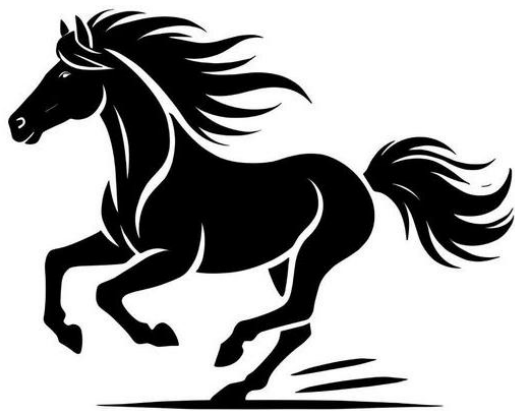

A **Khaki or Grey** two door All-Terrain Vehicle like the Jimny with a side view **White** Mbulzi Goat Ram on the **Black** grill as its emblem and the name **DENEL** in **Black** on its boot door that hinges on top and not at the side like the Jimny. This bakkie should make use of this same redesigned engine but this time an engine of 105 Kw should be fitted under the bonnet. This is an All-Terrain vehicle meant for farms, game parks, construction sites and mines that should have hand winding windows, no remote-control locking system, a needle speedometer and mechanical odometer with as little as possible of the unnecessary and unpractical electronics you get in modern cars that make them expensive, unreliable and unnecessary complex. This bakkie should have the same ruggedness as the 1980’s Toyota Land Cruiser or the latest Mahindra Bakkie, but with this modern and fuel-efficient drive train that generates electricity to power four electric motors mounted at each wheel. 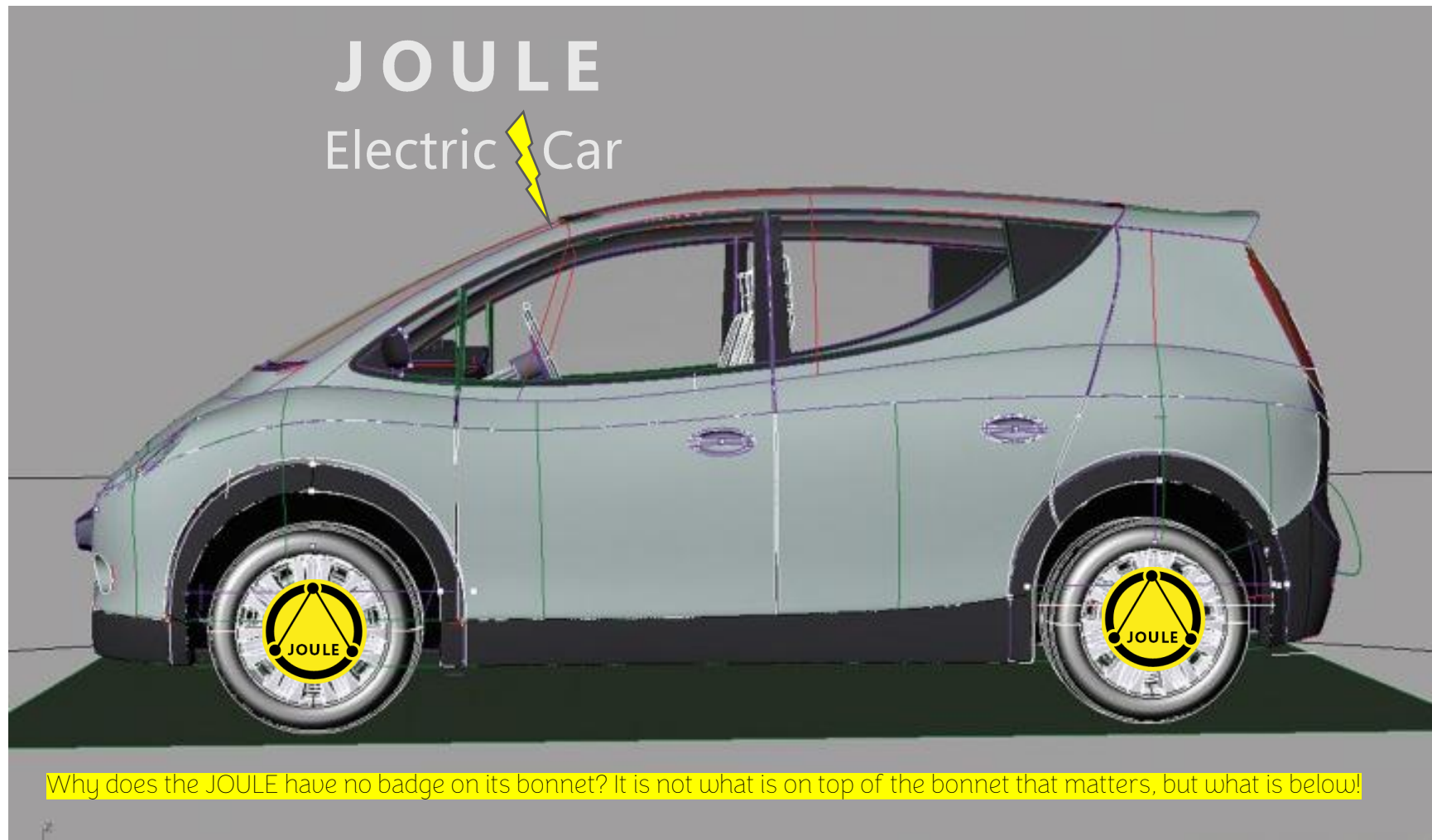




## Factory Layout

The assembly production line for motorcars was invented by Henry Ford to manufacture the Model T Ford for a lower price. He got the idea after he visited a cattle abattoir. Cattle are wild animals and are therefore all lined up in a narrow passageway in one group. After the first animal is killed the disassembly process starts by first hoisting up the heavy carcass and then moving it down a line of workers that each stays in one place. A car however is not disassembled from one wild big heavy part. It is rather assembled by adding relatively light and tame parts together. You can therefore put up a more efficient production line for cars by having multiple entry points and making the production line static and not dynamic. Then there will also be multiple exit points. This factory has twelve exit points. Just like the JOULE has a more efficient redesigned internal combustion engine, it must also be build on a more efficient redesigned static production line.

This factory design lends it perfectly to labour intensive manufacturing. The robots that are being used in modern car factories cannot compete either for cost or speed of assembly with a well-motivated team of workers. You have no capital cost with a worker while an expensive robot must be imported at great cost. Profit is not made by selling cars, it is made by building cars!



### People buy cars for three basic reasons

1. Practical reasons and utility like transportation, safety, fuel efficiency. The Joule's boot is big, as it has a small engine.
2. Emotional satisfaction and personal expression or identity. People buy cars that make them feel good, confident, reflect their values such as ruggedness for adventure or eco-friendly credentials. The emotional connection often overrides purely logical reasons. This fuel-efficient, hand-build, well-designed truly South African car will have the edge here.
3. Status, Prestige and achievement which all entails social signalling of success. The Joule looks like a hatch back Porsche!

## The Downside of a battery driven electric car industry like TESLA and BYD:

### **Key Findings on Copper Availability**

- Current copper mining rates are insufficient to fully electrify the global car fleet by 2050. While copper resources exist, production must increase by over 55% to meet demand, requiring dozens of new mines. EVs need 80–180 kg of copper compared to 20 kg for internal combustion engines (ICE), straining supply chains. While there is no permanent geological shortage, the speed of extraction and refining is the primary bottleneck.
- **The Gap:** To meet 2050 electrification goals, the world would need to mine more copper in the next 30 years than in all of human history prior to 2018.
- **Production Challenge:** Bringing new copper mines online takes an average of 23 years, making rapid scaling difficult.
- **Alternative Strategies:** A rapid shift to 100% hybrid vehicles by 2035 is seen as a more realistic, less resource-intensive alternative, as hybrids require much less copper than full EVs. *The Joule is a hybrid.*

### **Key Findings on Lithium Availability**

- **Resources vs. Production:** While lithium is abundant in the earth's crust, the bottleneck is not the total amount, but the speed at which it can be mined and processed into high-quality battery-grade material. Current global lithium production is roughly 100,000 tonnes per year, but by 2030, demand is expected to be 2.5 to 5 times higher.

**Battery Concerns:** Long-term battery health in hot climates and high replacement costs are risks for second-hand buyers.

**Charging Limitations:** Public charging infrastructure can be unreliable, sparse in rural areas, and charging takes much longer than filling a gas tank (30 minutes to over 12 hours).

**Range Anxiety & Efficiency:** Real-world range is reduced by cold/hot weather or high speeds, making long trips more difficult.

**Higher Initial Costs:** EVs often have a higher purchase price than comparable internal combustion engine vehicles, although this is improving

An EV cost R0.65/km to charge at home, but public **charging costs** R1.3/km. The fuel cost of the Joule will be R1/km including the fuel tax, as it will be able to do 20km/litre with its redesigned internal combustion engine without resorting to Hybrid technology which will improve it further. The engine is 30% more efficient than a conventional one and the energy transportation has very little friction compared to mechanical transport of energy. Because home charging of an EV is only taxed 15% VAT unlike the more than 30% tax levied on fuel at the pump the government will eventually levy other taxes on Electric Vehicles to make up for this unfair practice.

The other significant problem with EV's in South Africa is that they just **move the cars exhaust** pipe to the fossil fuel power station. EV's are therefore not more environmentally friendly unless their electricity is generated by green energy.

Because an EV does not work to generate its electricity it basically follows the same concept as a **parasite**, the same as a thief.

Even though it will be one year quicker to do the rehabilitation of the criminals if a second group of Army soldiers build another set of 31,800 prison cells in year two, it is good enough to do it in four years. The prisons build in the second year will only be used twice. If one build just one set of prison cells they can be used six times over a 3-year period and the cost will be cut in half. Once the first three sets of prisoners are out of the existing prisons at the beginning of semester 5, then all criminals that are newly prosecuted can be temporally locked up in the old prisons, because there will now be space for them in the previously overcrowded old prisons.

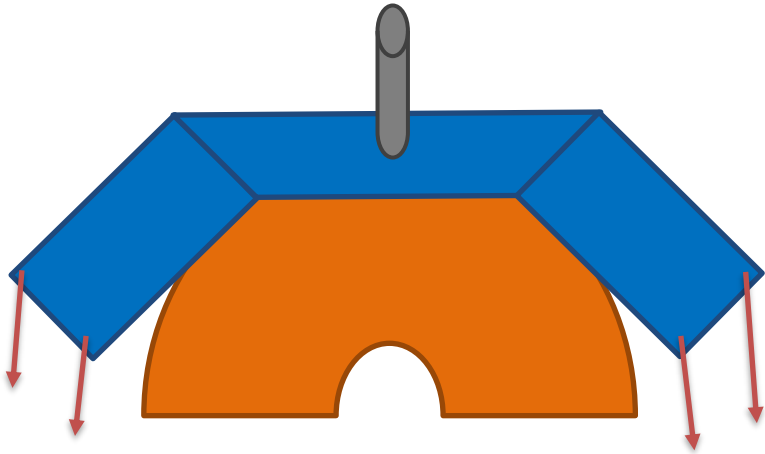

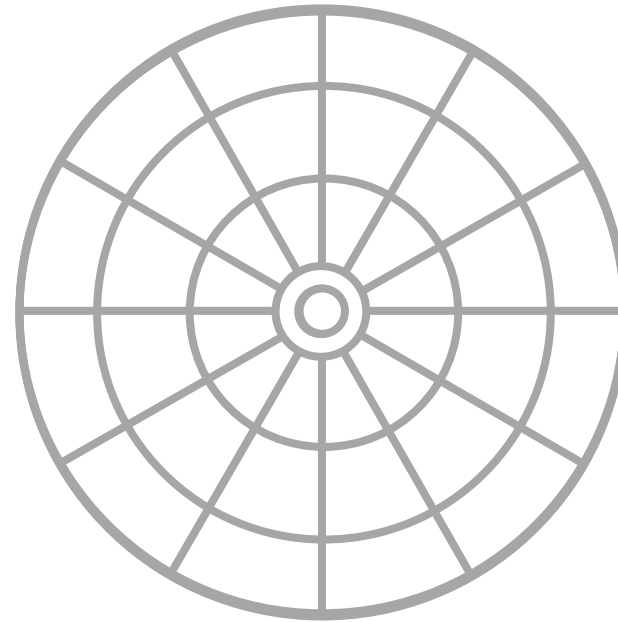

### Hiking Hut build by Army Divisions 1, 2 and 3 in Indigenous Style.



The metal frame on the right of the Indigenous Hut is covered by Brown Bonsmara cattle skins which are stretched in place while still wet but treated with salt. Over this is put a blue canvas which are then anchored down into the ground. In the middle of the hut is a wooden cooking stove. The army must also install a water storage tank, build an outside shower bathroom, toilet, evaporation cooler pantry, and small water catchment weir in a stream that will feed the storage tank, shower, toilet and evaporation cooler.



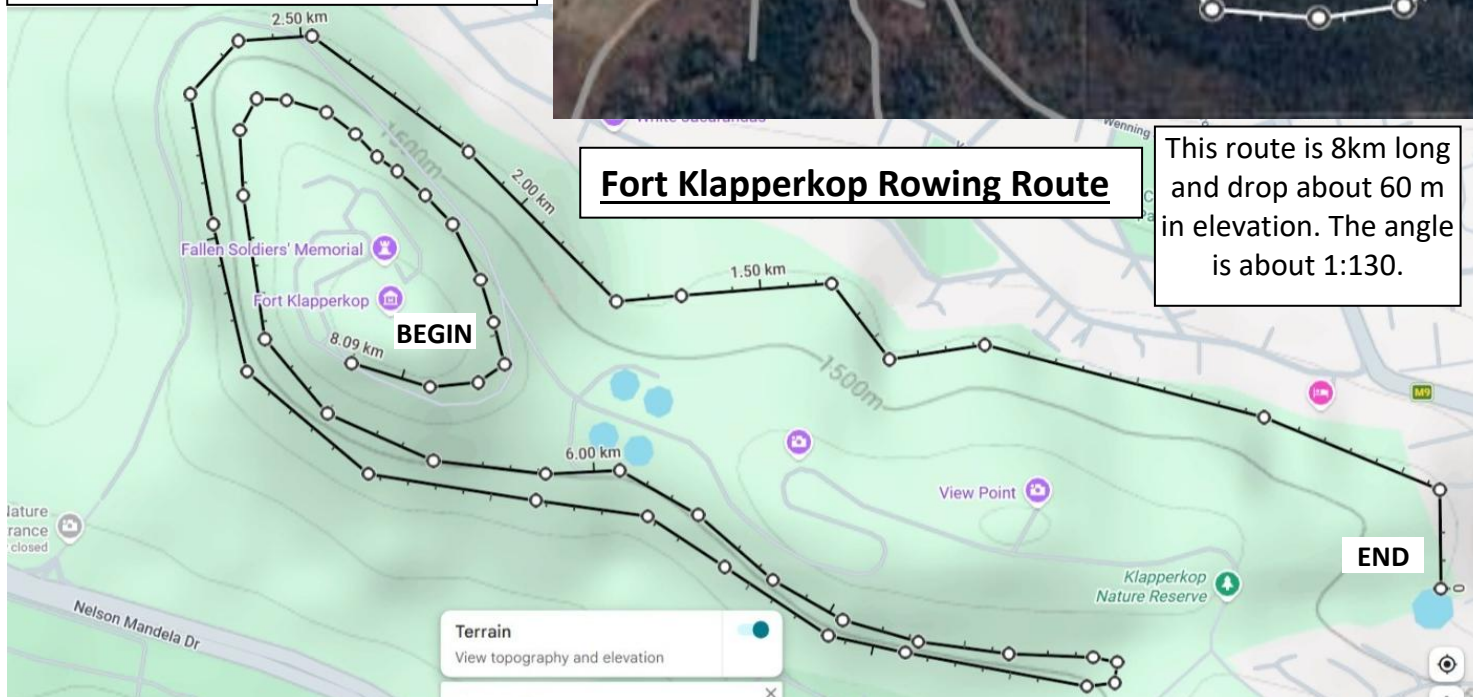
The vertical frame of the Indigenous Hut is made of twelve 25 mm stainless steel pipes rolled into a 3.8-meter radius each. The base of the floor has a diameter of 8 meters. The hut is 3.8 meters high in the centre. The horizontal supports are 8mm steel bars rolled into diameters of 3.8m 2.8 and 1.8m that are tied to each vertical support and pulled tight. If hikers sleep with their heads to the wall and their feet towards the centre one hut will be able to accommodate a maximum of twelve people.

Two **Kajak rowing routes** build by **Army Division 5** down the contour lines of these two iconic fortified (bronze) hills spoken of in Zachariah 6:1. The route start at the top of the hill at the forts and circles down the contour line to a pond at the bottom of the hill. The route comes in the shape of a canal dug by a small excavator. The water is pumped at a rate of 28 litres/second or 100m<sup>3</sup>/h which results in a flow speed of 1.4 m/s in a 160mm PVC pipe if a 50kw motor is used.



### **Fort Schanskop Rowing Route**

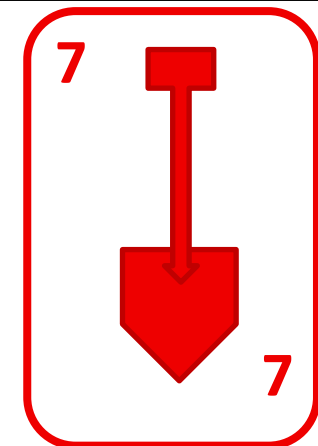
This route is 3.6km long and drop about 80 m in elevation. The average angle is about 1:45. This route will therefore have more whitewater.



### **Fort Klapperkop Rowing Route**

This route is 8km long and drop about 60 m in elevation. The angle is about 1:130.

If the canal is 2metres wide and the water flow 160mm high, then the subcritical flow speed will be 312 m/h.



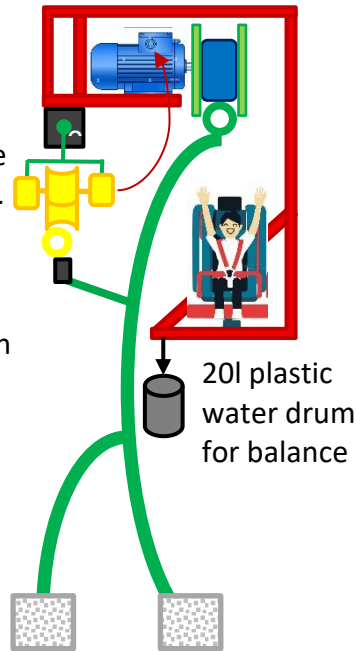
## The Kruger National Park elevated rail line & car build by Army Division 4

The rail car runs on a 32mm inside diameter steel pipe, with a 200mm diameter blue elastic rubber wheel with thread width 46mm, made by Rybro SA. The car frame is made with a single red painted 38mm square tubing supported at the corners for strength.

Energy is provided by an electrical copper wire cable with copper pulley running on top to pick up electricity.

A 32 mm steel pipe (42.2mm outside diameter & 4.85mm wall thickness) has a safe yielding moment of 1100 Nm. Because an occupied rail car weighs 150kg, the vertical green posts must be spaced every 2.99m. By welding two 40mm steel flat bars at the bottom of the pipe this distance can be increased to every 5 meters.

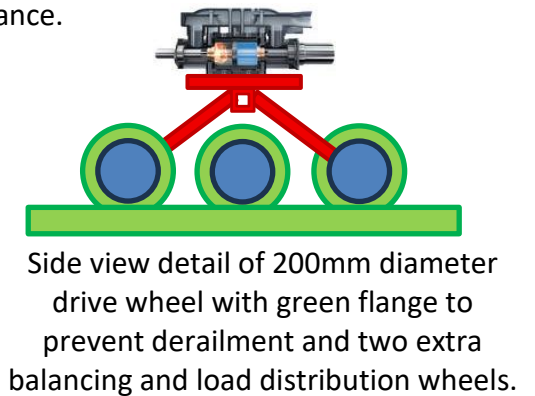
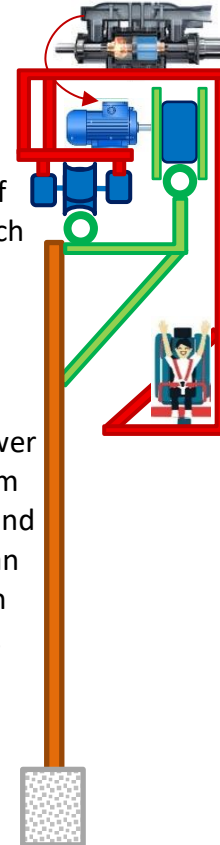
If the 200mm diameter blue drive wheel turns at 750 rev/min the max speed of this vehicle will be 28 km/h which is just right for game viewing.



Alternatively install a redesigned engine on top that generates electricity for the 7.5 kW electric motor. The 15kg engine can be shifted for balance.

Bearings on both sides of pulley to attach it to frame.

Eucalyptus power line pole of 7m tall above ground so a giraffe can walk through underneath.

It takes one hour to build a cell by a group of 6 soldiers. This means they build 9 cells per day. There are 6 groups of 6 soldiers in each division. They will use two days to prepare the parts of each cell, for ease and speed of construction and then assemble the cells over 4 days each week. Each Division will therefore build in a week =  $9 \times 4 \times 6 = 216$  per week. If they take four holidays of 1 week, 2 weeks, 1 week and then 4 weeks they will spend 44 weeks of the year building. Total number of cells each division can build in a year is  $216 \times 44 = 9504$ . The three divisions can therefore build  $9504 \times 3 = 28\,512$  cells in one year. The number of cells left for the Indian Division of 12 men to build is therefore  $31\,104 - 28\,512 = 2592$ . This will take them  $2592 / (9 \times 4 \times 2) = 36$  weeks to complete. This will give the Indian Division 8 weeks to complete 2592 shower cubicles. It takes about the same time to build 4 cubicles as it would to build one cell. They will therefore take  $2592 / (4 \text{ per hour} \times 9\text{h/day} \times 5 \text{ days build/week} \times 2 \text{ groups}) = 7.2$  weeks to build all the shower cubicles. The other ablution facilities of these prisons are a topic for another time, but it is less technically difficult to construct. All Prisons with 60 cells in a row, must get 5 showers at the end of each row and those with 72 cells in a row, must get 6 showers at the end of each row. If the guard accompanying a group of 5 or 6 prisoners, depending on the number of showers he has, takes 10 minutes from leaving the cell, showering and then back per group of 5 or 6 prisoners, it will take his whole group of prisoners 2 hours to shower. They will go for a shower on a Saturday afternoon. Week afternoons they will spend half an hour per person inside their cells developing a craft that they can use to earn money once they are rehabilitated and also as a way to get mental stimulation. The day will start at 7:30 when a guard will start to make coffee by heating two kettles water on a gas plate. He will heat 6.5 litres per kettle if he has 60 prisoners and

7.5 litres if he has 72 prisoners. Once he has put the water on the stove, he will walk down the row and open the small drop doors inside the cell door that is used for serving food and drink into the cell, as well as to cuff the prisoner while he is pushing his hands through the opening from the inside. On the way back he will also let the window shutter of each cell down. He can then greet each person and see if he is good. Once the water is above 80 degrees Celsius, he throws half a box of 500gram Koffiehuis Gold in each kettle on the stove and stir. After a minute he adds a litre of milk and wait two more minutes. Then he goes down isle with the two kettles in a wheelbarrow, pushed by a different prisoner each day, to serve each prisoner a coffee inside a plastic mug that the prisoner keeps inside the cell with him. Before he starts, he first must put the water for the maize porridge on the stove. If there are 60 prisoners in his group, he must heat 6 litres in four 10 litre pots each on two gas stove plates and if there is 72 prisoners he must heat 7.2 litres in four 10 litre pots each. When the water is heated, he adds 2 litres of maize meal for 60 prisoners and 2.4 litres of maize meal for 72 prisoners. After coffee each Guard take groups of 10, if he has 60 prisoners under him and 12, if he has 72 prisoners under him, for a run from their prison cells to the end of the row, then to the other end of the row and then back to their cells. To cut a long story short these prisoners will be treated with respect and dignity if they give their cooperation unlike the current prison system which is more like animal housing. This will be Fivestar treatment compared to what they are used to at a fraction of the price. These prisons won't cost 500 million to build per year. The current budget of correctional services is 50 times that. The current government works incredibly inefficient with the people of South Africa's hard earned tax money. No wonder a packet of cigarettes is so expensive. The biggest problem is however that the police make one million arrests per year and they only get 3 percent or 30 000 convictions per year. This means not only is the criminal justice system broken but its also overwhelmed. The prisons can't handle 1 million prisoners per year. There is only space for 100 000 in total. The only solution to this problem is therefore leadership from the government which is totally absent at this stage. Have anybody ever seen a governmental law posted up, or emphasized in any way from a public platform like Do not steal or Do not murder or Do not Rape. Nothing. Not a peep. This has to and will change if the AC/DC takes over the government of South Africa.

**Eight of Clubs** In order to use a six-month rehabilitation program for criminals the Death penalty must be reinstated for aggravated murder or premeditated murder after the initial amnesty period has expired. 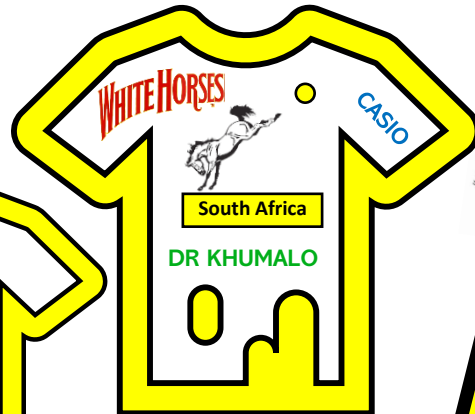

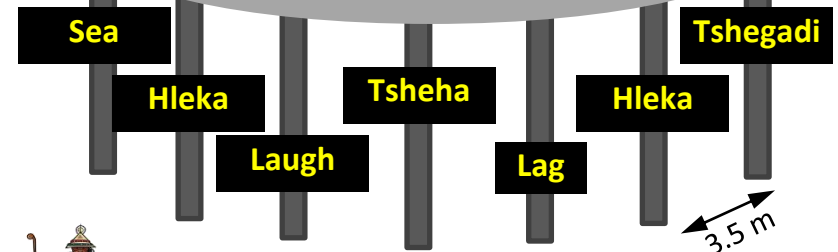
